Thank you so much for the meeting today.

We have a lot to do in a very short time frame – but I know we can! Everything we need for our 11/17 bocc agenda item is due to our administrator by 11/2. So:

I am summarizing what has to happen – please edit if I miss anything:

Joaquin/FDOT will provide by Thursday, Oct 28, 2010:

- The 2 documents that are studies that demonstrate how segment flow rates were determined.
- 2. Maximum traffic flow at count stations requested by Christine
- 3. Information related to signal flow (with no southbound turning because green lights to allow flow of traffic out of Keys) requested by Ken Metcalf
- 4. A memorandum that indicates three scenarios with recommendation to Reid to change the number of "Evacuation Outbound Lanes" in the model, for three separate model runs including: this needs to be an exhibit to Reids report
  - a. Completed projects from Table 18 of the 2001 study
  - b. Projects under construction from Table 18 of the 2001 study
  - c. Projects under design from Table 18 of the 2001 study
- 5. Add 2 columns to the FDOT Work Program Table that indicates whether additional capacity is added for improvement under day to day operations and under hurricane evacuation this needs to be an exhibit to Reids report

### Reid will:

- 1. Run the model with the three scenarios in 2 a, b, and c above and edit his summary table to demonstrate those scenarios by adding rows to the table with results.
- 2. Edit table 31, page 23 to add columns after "Evacuation Outbound Lanes" to demonstrate three new scenarios
- 3. Clarify Clearance time is the total time starting at 30 hours and ending at Florida City page 1 (2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph)
- 4. Page 24 eliminate "Updated Miller Model" paragraph and

- 5. Subtract 52 minutes from Table 32 Clearance Times for every scenario demonstrated in Clearance Times Estimates
- 6. Revise Table 32.
  - Eliminate row that shows Miller Flow Rates (Maybe) depending on REBECCA'S ANSWER AFTER SHE TALKS TO CHARLIE GAUTHIER
  - b. Add three tows at the bottom to demonstrate three scenarios Completed, Under Construction, and Under Design
