ORDER

This matter comes before me for final Department Order.

Having fully considered the Special Deputy's Recommended Order and the record of the case and in the absence of any exceptions to the Recommended Order, I adopt the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as set forth therein. A copy of the Recommended Order is attached and incorporated in this Final Order.

In consideration thereof, it is ORDERED that the Petitioner's protest of the determination dated December 24, 2013, is dismissed due to lack of jurisdiction.

JUDICIAL REVIEW

Any request for judicial review must be initiated within 30 days of the date the Order was filed. Judicial review is commenced by filing one copy of a *Notice of Appeal* with the DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY at the address shown at the top of this Order and a second copy, with filing fees prescribed by law, with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. It is the responsibility of the party appealing to the Court to prepare a transcript of the record. If no court reporter was at the hearing, the transcript must be prepared from a copy of the Special Deputy's hearing recording, which may be requested from the Office of Appeals.

RECOMMENDED ORDER OF SPECIAL DEPUTY

DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY

This matter comes before the undersigned Special Deputy pursuant to the Petitioner's protest of the Respondent's determination dated December 24, 2013.

After due notice to the parties, a telephone hearing was held on March 20, 2014. The Petitioner, represented by its president, appeared and testified. The Respondent, represented by a Department of Revenue Tax Auditor III, appeared and testified.

The record of the case, including the recording of the hearing and any exhibits submitted in evidence, is herewith transmitted. Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law were received from the Petitioner. Although the Petitioner's submission is dated January 24, 2014, the date appears to be in error since the submission refers to the hearing held on March 20, 2014, and was timely submitted on April 4, 2014.

ISSUE: Whether the Petitioner's tax rates were properly computed, pursuant to §443.131, Florida Statutes; Rules 73B-10.026; 10.031, Florida Administrative Code.

ISSUE: Whether the Petitioner's liability for unemployment compensation contributions was properly determined pursuant to Sections 443.1215, 1216, 1217; 443.131, Florida Statutes.

ISSUE: Whether the Petitioner filed a timely protest pursuant to §443.131(3)(i); 443.1312(2); 443.141(2); Florida Statutes; Rule 73B-10.035, Florida Administrative Code.

Findings of Fact:

1. On December 16, 2013, the Department of Revenue mailed a determination to the Petitioner's correct mailing address. The determination was dated as mailed on or before December 24, 2013.

2. The Petitioner's president was on vacation during the latter part of December 2013 and received the determination when she returned to work on January 2, 2014.

- 3. Among other things the determination advises "This is an official notice of your tax rate and will become conclusive and binding unless you file a <u>written</u> request for redetermination, including your grounds for review in accordance with Rule 73B-10.035 of the Florida Administrative Code within twenty (20) days from the date of this letter."
- 4. The determination also advised the Petitioner that the determination will result in additional tax and interest due. On January 2, 2014, the Petitioner's president telephoned the Tax Auditor III who created the determination for an explanation. The Tax Auditor III explained the determination, advised the Petitioner of the appeal rights, and advised the Petitioner to contact the service center if the Petitioner wanted to set up a time payment plan for payment of the additional tax and interest.
- 5. The Petitioner contacted the local service center concerning a time payment plan and also contacted the Petitioner's accountant. On January 24, 2014, the Petitioner's president wrote a letter protesting the determination. The Petitioner mailed the protest letter to the Department of Revenue by mail postmarked January 25, 2014.

Conclusions of Law:

- 6. Section 443.141(2), Florida Statutes, provides:
 - (c) Appeals. The department and the state agency providing reemployment assistance tax collection services shall adopt rules prescribing the procedures for an employing unit determined to be an employer to file an appeal and be afforded an opportunity for a hearing on the determination. Pending a hearing, the employing unit must file reports and pay contributions in accordance with s. 443.131.
- 7. Rule 73B-10.035, Florida Administrative Code provides;
 - (1) Filing a Protest. Protests of determinations of liability, assessments, reimbursement requirements, and tax rates are filed by writing to the Department of Revenue in the time and manner prescribed on the determination document. Upon receipt of a written protest, DOR will issue a redetermination if appropriate. If a redetermination is not issued, the letter of protest, determination, and all relevant documentation will be forwarded to the Office of Appeals, Special Deputy Section, in DEO for resolution.
- 8. Rule 73B-10.035, Florida Administrative Code, provides:
 - (5) Timely Protest.
 - (a)1. Determinations issued pursuant to Sections 443.1216, 443.131-.1312, F.S., will become final and binding unless application for review and protest is filed with the Department within 20 days from the mailing date of the determination. If not mailed, the determination will become final 20 days from the date the determination is delivered.
- 9. Rule 73B-10.022, Florida Administrative Code, provides:
 - (5) Computation of time: In computing any period of time prescribed, calendar days are counted; the date of issuance of a notice is not counted. The last day of the period is counted unless it is a Saturday, Sunday, or holiday; in which event the period will run until the end of the next day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or holiday. Holidays are those dates designated by Section 110.117(1) and (2), F.S., and any other day that the offices of the United States Postal Service are closed.

10. The determination was dated as mailed on or before December 24, 2013, was mailed to the Petitioner's correct mailing address, and was timely received by the Petitioner. The Petitioner did not file a written protest until mail postmarked January 25, 2014. When the Petitioner did not file a written protest by January 13, 2014, twenty days after December 24, 2013, the determination issued by the Department of Revenue became final and may not be disturbed.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the Petitioner's protest of the determination dated December 24, 2013, be DISMISSED due to lack of jurisdiction.
