Displaced Homemaker Trust Fund

The State Treasury maintains a trust fund specifically designated to receive and disburse to the Displaced Homemaker Program, revenue generated from an additional fee on marriage license applications and dissolution of marriage filings. The amount of \$12.50 is collected from each marriage license application, and \$7.50 is collected from dissolution of marriage petitions. These fees collected by the Clerks of the Court in each county are transferred each month to the State Treasury and deposited in the Displaced Homemaker Trust Fund.

The Agency for Workforce Innovation is to use these funds to administer the Displaced Homemaker Program and to fund displaced homemaker service delivery programs according to Chapter 446, Florida Statutes, and the Displaced Homemaker Program Three-Year State Plan. Funds that are not expended by the Agency for Workforce Innovation at the end of the budget cycle or through a supplemental budget approved by the Agency for Workforce Innovation revert to the Trust Fund.
