

SUBJECT: Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL) Wage Rates Adjusted By Local RWB Areas for 2007

PURPOSE

The purpose for the following table of the Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL) Wage Rates for 2007 is to provide wage rate values by region which will be used in various reporting measures. These values have been adjusted according to the social and economic criteria for the differences in the area of local Regional Workforce Boards. The adjusted values shown are compared to the prior year for informational purposes. These local wage rates can further be used to establish policies prioritizing limited availability of services by the Regional Workforce Boards (RWBs).

ACTION REQUIRED

These guidelines will be used in performance measures containing employment wage rates. Regional Workforce Boards are encouraged to provide this information to all associates and interested parties.
