Dear Ms. Newton:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, Public Law 93-288, as amended, I have authorized an initial obligation in the amount of \$282,154 (\$244,829 for benefits and \$37,325 for administrative costs) for the purpose of continuing Section 410 of the Act in the State of Florida.

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) may authorize additional program funding, as required, based on justification from your agency. Any supplemental funding requests must be accompanied by a complete program account of previously awarded funds before any additional funds will be approved. The request must include the current information concerning the number of applicants who filed for Disaster Unemployment Assistance, the number of approved applications, the total number of benefit weeks paid out to applicants, the total benefit dollars paid, a break-out of State administrative costs incurred (personnel, benefits, travel, publications, printing, postage), and a detailed accounting of why additional funding is requested.

The State must account for this advance in accordance with 2. C.F.R. Part 200.300, **Statutory and National Policy Requirements**. All financial records, supporting documents, statistical records, and other records pertinent to this advance shall be retained and shall be accessible to duly authorized representatives of the U.S. Comptroller General for the purpose of making audits for a period of three years starting from the date of submission of the final financial reporting form ETA-9130 (2 C.F.R. 200.333).
