THUNDERSTORMS

PRODUCING VERY HEAVY RAINFALL ACROSS THE AREA. THESE STORMS ARE  
PRODUCING RAINFALL RATES OF AROUND 2 INCHES PER HOUR...WITH TOTAL  
ACCUMULATIONS OF UP TO 4 INCHES POSSIBLE.

EXCESSIVE RUNOFF FROM THESE STORMS WILL CAUSE FLOODING OF URBAN  
AREAS...HIGHWAYS...STREETS AND UNDERPASSES AS WELL AS OTHER  
DRAINAGE  
AREAS.

KEEP IN MIND THAT SOME OF THE HEAVIER RAIN WAS FALLING OVER  
ALREADY  
SATURATED GROUND. THIS WILL CAUSE CONTINUED FLOODING OF LOW  
LYING  
AREAS...SUCH AS SMALL STREAMS AND CREEKS.

DO NOT DRIVE YOUR VEHICLE INTO AREAS WHERE WATER COVERS THE  
ROADWAY.  
THE WATER DEPTH MAY BE TOO GREAT TO ALLOW YOUR CAR TO CROSS  
SAFELY.  
IT ONLY TAKES A FOOT OR TWO OF WATER TO SWEEP MOST CARS AWAY.
