- Q. What is a budget, really?
 - Yes, it is a document with a bunch of numbers and dollar figures.
 - More importantly, it is the most significant POLICY DOCUMENT used in government planning.
 - "The budget process is the spinal column of public policymaking."

Basic Assumptions

- Early childhood systems initiatives must achieve a deep understanding of the budget in order to influence the policy decisions that impact young children ages 0-5.
- A cross-system plan without a cross-system budget is difficult to implement.






















Beginning to Move the Early Childhood Systems Agenda into the State Budget
