SUBJECT: Appropriations to Continue the Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA) for Workers and Alternative Trade Adjustment Assistance (ATAA) and Reemployment Trade Adjustment Assistance (RTAA) Program Operations for Fiscal Year (FY) 2015

Please find in the below link Training and Employment Guidance (TEGL) 16-14 issued by the United States Department of Labor transmitting guidance regarding the continuation of the Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA) program through Fiscal Year (FY) 2015. This guidance supersedes any correspondence on the termination of TAA in FY 2015 that states may have received previously.

On December 31, 2014, Congress passed the FY 2015 Omnibus Appropriations Act, which was signed into law by President Barack Obama on December 16, 2014 (Pub. L. 113-235). The FY 2015 Omnibus Appropriations Act has the effect of continuing the full operation of the TAA program through September 30, 2015. Therefore, Regional Workforce Boards should continue to operate the program in accordance with previously issued federal guidelines.
