SUBJECT: 2024 Federal Poverty Guidelines

On January 11, 2024, the United States Department of Health and Human Services published the 2024 poverty guidelines in the Federal Register. The guidelines became effective January 17, 2024. The poverty guidelines are used to calculate income levels to determine if individuals meet the mandated requirements for funded services in various workforce programs.

Persons in Household	Poverty Guideline
1	\$15,060
2	\$20,440
3	\$25,820
4	\$31,200
5	\$36,580
6	\$41,960
7	\$47,340
8	\$52,720

For families/households with more than eight (8) persons, add \$5,380 for each additional person.
