



SUBJECT: Veterans' Program Letter (VPL) 07-09

The U.S. Department of Labor (USDOL) has provided additional information and clarification on the implementation of Priority of Service for veterans and eligible spouses in all qualified job training programs, funded in whole or in part by the USDOL.

USDOL provides grants to the State of Florida to provide employment and training services to eligible residents and workers. As a condition to receiving those funds, priority of service will be given to qualified veterans and eligible spouses when referring individuals to job openings, to all USDOL funded training programs in whole or in part or related services in accordance with the Veterans' Priority Provisions of the "Jobs for Veterans Act"(JVA) (PL 107-288), and Veterans' Benefits, Health Care, and Information Technology Act of 2006 (Pub. L. 109-461).
