## **PURPOSE:**

To issue a copy of the Employment and Training Administration's (ETA) Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) on Continuation of Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA) for Workers and Alternative Trade Adjustment Assistance (ATAA) Programs.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Trade Act of 2002 was authorized through September 30, 2007 and was extended to December 31, 2007 and operating under a Continuing Resolution until further notice. Since reauthorization of the TAA program is pending before Congress, ETA has issued guidance that the program remains under a Continuing Resolution through September 30, 2008.

# **ACTION REQUIRED:**

The regional workforce boards should continue to serve those eligible trade-affected individuals who qualify for services and benefits under the TAA program. Please note that there are adequate TAA funds available at the state-level should you need additional funds for training-related costs.
