SUBJECT: Program Year (PY) 2018-2019 Revised Monitoring Review Schedule

Due to ongoing disaster recovery and relief efforts in the panhandle and neighboring gulf coast areas resulting from Hurricane Michael, the Department of Economic Opportunity's Bureau of One-Stop and Program Support has revised the monitoring review schedule for Program Year 2018-19 (see revised schedule attached).

The monitoring review schedule has been adjusted to move several Local Workforce Development Board (LWDB) monitoring review dates that were originally scheduled for calendar year 2018 to alternate review dates in calendar year 2019.
