The purpose of this memorandum is to inform Local Workforce Development Boards of the upcoming due date to submit applications for Subsequent Local Workforce Development Area (LWDA) Designation and Local Board Composition Rosters. As required under section 106 of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA), CareerSource Florida will grant subsequent designation of a local area if, for the two most recent program years, the LWDA performed successfully and sustained fiscal integrity. Additionally, the CareerSource Florida Board of Directors must certify each local board as required under section 107, WIOA.

Applications for Subsequent Local Workforce Development Area Designation and Local Board Composition Rosters and are due on or before close of business <u>April 16, 2021</u>.
