SUBJECT: CPR and OSHA Certifications

In response to several questions regarding whether CPR or OSHA certificates count for the *Attainment of a Degree or Certificate WIA Performance* measure, we want to make Regional Workforce Boards aware of published Department of Labor guidance relating to this matter. According to the federal guidance, CPR and OSHA certificates do not count for the degree/certificate measure as they do not meet ETA's intent of its credential definition.
